- Undertake the coordination of HIH EA (Tz) value chain activities and guide the actualization of the various value chains by HIH Tanzania members.
- Facilitate, identify, and maintain strong partnerships with relevant national institutions and international institutions, private sector organizations, cooperatives partners through value chain platforms and facilitate the channelling of cutting-edge practical expertise to the members including Workshops in agricultural marketing issues and Field days / market fares / exhibitions.
